How to play:

- 1 Cut cards apart (I recommend starting with 10-15 word pairs and a cruella de vil card and as your child learns more then add more pairs or swap out pairs so the game doesn't get too long)
- 2 1-2 player use 10 sight word pairs and Cruella card
- 3 3-4 players use 15 sight word pairs and Cruella card
- 4 5-10 players use 20-25 sight word pairs and Cruella card
- 5 Youngest player goes first
- Players should take turns taking one card from an opponent of their choice. (they do not get to see the cards) They should reach out and take one card without knowing what it is.
- If the card they take is a match to a card in their hand they get to take another turn. If not, gameplay resumes with the next player.
- 8 Encourage players to say the sight words out loud as they match them.
- The game ends when all words have been matched. The player holding Cruella De Vil is the Old Maid! Have fun!
